In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1852, <sup>and the act of August 30, 1852, amend[ing] the former,</sup> also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Lewis Ames, of Livingston, Chaut. Co. New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he is the owner of One half part, and Martin Ames, of the same place own the remaining one half part, and do

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the S. A. Blake of Buffalo, whereof Samuel Ames is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula Ohio in the year 1850 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port, May 13, 1852, No 73, now returned having changed names And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is Forty eight feet and three inches 48 ft. 3 in her breadth Sixteen feet and three inches 16 ft. 3 in her depth Four feet and three inches 4 ft. 3 in and that she measures Twenty seven tons Sixty four ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern and Scull head And the said Lewis Ames having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
