In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed ^{the Act of August 20, 1852, amending the same.} 7th July, 1852, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Erastus Crooker, of Buffalo, N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of one equal undivided three fourth parts of the Steam Boat "Garden City of Buffalo" that George Crooker, of Black Rock, Erie Co. N.Y. is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided one fourth part of said Vessel and one

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the "Garden City of Buffalo" whereof Erastus Crooker

is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y., in the year 1853 as appears by the Certificate of Vincent Bidwell Shipwright in file in this office

And the Superior Surveyor having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has Three Decks and no masts, and that her length is Three hundred and seventeen feet and three inches 217 ft. 3 in. her breadth Twenty nine feet and ten inches 29 ft. 10 in. her depth Ten feet and six inches 10 ft. 6 in. and that she measures Six hundred and fifty seven, three thirty one ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat has a Square Stern and no figure head

And the said Erastus Crooker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
