In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licencing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

William Campbell of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Caroline Ames whereof William Campbell is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at

Little Salmon Creek, in the year 1849, as appears by the Enrollment dated at this port July 28 1853 and Number 108 now amended having

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is Ninety feet and six inches 90 ft 6 in her breadth Nineteen feet and eight inches 19 8 in her depth Eight feet and nine inches 8 9 in and that she measures 142 tons 100 net weight, that she is a Schooner has no head

And the said Oliver R. Ames William Campbell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
