In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Alanson Robinson of the City of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of 67/100 parts of the Propeller Paussett and that John M. Woolsey, who resides at Cleveland in the State of Ohio owned the remaining 10/100 parts of said Propeller and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Propeller Paussett whereof J. D. Beaupre is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City Ohio. in the year 1847 as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port July 31, 1852 now renewed having changed owner,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred and forty feet 140 ft her breadth Seventy two feet four and a half inches 72.4 1/2 in her depth Nin feet and nine inches 9.9 and that she measures Two hundred thirty six ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has No sails and a figure head

And the said Alanson Robinson having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
