In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for securing the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at the City of Buffalo in the State of New York and owns ¹²⁰/₁₀₀ of the parts of the Propeller Oregon & is the Managing Owner hereof, and that John W. Hooley resides at the City of Cleveland Ohio and owns the remaining ²⁷/₁₀₀ parts of said Propeller and that they are both of them

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Oregon whereof Edw. McKim is Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1845, as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port May 8th 1852, No 69, New hundred having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that, the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that, her length is One hundred & forty four feet 144 ft her breadth Twenty three feet and three inches 23 ft, 3 in her depth Nine feet and ten inches 9, 10 and that she measures 312 ^{tons} and that she is a Propeller has a Galeys and a round stern and a bow head

And the said Alanson Robinson having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
