In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Andrew D. Ellis of Buffalo, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing Owner of the Propeller called the "Wilmorland" and that John Ball owns the remaining one equal undivided fourth part thereof that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller "Wilmorland" of Buffalo whereof John Ball is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of Saffinier and Stinson Shipwrights, her builder on file in this Office

And Thos. Hoffman Major Appointed to Mate said Vessel, having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one Mast and that her length is two hundred feet two & 3/4 inches 300 ft 2 3/4 in her breadth twenty eight feet two & 3/4 inches 28 ft 2 3/4 in her depth twelve feet two inches and 3/4 of an inch 12 ft 2 3/4 in and that she measures six hundred & sixty five tons eighty four ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square Stern and a round head

And the said Andrew D. Ellis having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said
