In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Warren Niles of the City of Buffalo New York, Managing Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at the City of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek that he together with John R. Wheeler who resides at the same place are the owners of the remains of the Undivided three fourths parts of the Propeller New England by co-partnership under the firm name of Niles Wheeler and that J. W. Steele who resides at Cleveland Ohio owns the remainder of said Propeller, and that they are all of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller New England or Vessel called the New England whereof J. W. Steele is at present Master and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City in the State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of Luther Moss, Shipwright, her builder on file in this office

And Phocion Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred thirty four feet & five inches 134 ft, 5 in her breadth Twenty feet and six inches 20 ft, 6 in her depth Eleven feet 11 ft and that she measures 357 tons 67 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Square Stern and No figure head

And the said Warren Niles and No figure head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said

has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
