In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Silas M. Allen of Buffalo in the State of New York Managing Owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he together with Harlow, Millard who resides at the same place and the owners of the undivided New One eighth parts of the Bark "Trade Wind" of Buffalo are Copartners of the firm of S. M. Allen & Co. each owning an equal interest therein, and that the remainder of our eighth part of said Vessel is owned by James M. White of Jefferson County in the State of New York, that they are all of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Bark "Trade Wind" whereof said S. M. White is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Stony Brook State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by her last clearance dated at July 10, 1853 at the Port of Sacketts Harbor, New York and the said Bark having arrived at the place of residence of his former partner
