In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Nelson A Fox of Buffalo N. York Managing
Owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the sole owner of the Brig called the *Greyhound* of Buffalo and that *Elijah A Jones* of the same place owns the remainder of said Brig and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig *Greyhound* of Buffalo whereof *Wm O Robinson* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Convent* Ohio in the year 1853 as appears by the Certificate of *William Leut* he builder on file in this Office

And *Proctor Hoffman* having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has *One Deck* and *two masts (2)* her length is *One hundred and thirty* her breadth *Twenty eight* her depth *Eleven feet* and that she measures *367* tons that she is a *Sloop* and *W Cole* head

And the said *Nelson A Fox* and *W Cole* head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this *5* day of *November* in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty *three*,
