In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Samuel F. Pratt of Buffalo New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the State of New York, and District of Buffalo Creek, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the
J. N. Buckins of Buffalo N.Y. whereof Peter S. Allen,
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Auruburgh Canada ~~and~~
in the year 1844, as appears by his last enrollment dated at this
port August 11, 1853, No 53, and that ~~she was~~ afterwards condemned for a
violation of the United States Revenue Laws, and made an American Vessel
which enrollment is now annulled the said Propeller having changed

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast and that
her length is One hundred thirty three feet 133 feet
her breadth Twenty five 25"
her depth Eight feet and four inches 9" Her
and that she has Two hundred & eighty nine tons Twenty eight ninety-fifths
that she is a Propeller and no figure head

And the said Samuel F. Pratt and no figure head head
having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
