In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

And the Enrollment Indiana of Buffalo having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is One Hundred and forty six feet and two inches and that her breadth is Twenty three feet and three inches and that she measures 349 tons 34 ninety-fifths and that she is a Propeller has a round stern

And the said Samuel J. Prato and no figure head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Samuel J. Prato has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
