PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

John B. Jarvis, of New York City, President of the Michigan Southern Rail Road Company, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the President of the above mentioned Company which a Corporation created by the laws of the State of Michigan, that no foreigner or foreigners own any part of the Steam Boat called the Empire State of Buffalo, N.Y. that said Company has an Office and place of business at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and is the sole owner of the

Citizen of the United States, and the name of the said Steam Boat or Vessel called the Empire State of Buffalo whereof John Wilson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at St Clair State of Michigan in the year 1848, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port March 26, 1852, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has One deck and One Mast and that her length is three hundred fourteen feet 314 feet her breadth thirty seven feet 37 feet her depth four feet and five inches 4 feet 5 inches and that she measures 1001 tons 29 ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat and has a figure head

And the said John B. Jarvis and head having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 14 day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty three
