In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Elijah H. Bruce of Buffalo N.Y.
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is resident of the District of Buffalo Creek and a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the
 Caroline Ann of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Little Island Creek State of New York in the year 1849, as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port November 18 1853 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one and two masts and that her length is 90 feet 8 inches her breadth 19 " 8 " her depth 8 " 9 " 1 1/2 tons 60 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no head

And the said Elijah H. Bruce and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Ship or Vessel has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
