In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Reuben Dill of Buffalo New York, Managing Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the sole owner of the Schooner *Virginia Parody* in the District of Buffalo Creek & owned two equal undivided one fourth parts of the Schooner called the *Virginia Parody* of Buffalo that *Samuel Smith* of Malden Massachusetts, *Walterfield Wilton* of Rusk & Barry and *Chas P Chaufferlain* all of Boston Mass, each own the one equal undivided one sixteenth part of said Schooner and all said above named owned an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner *Virginia Parody* whereof *Reuben Dill* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ohio* State of *Ohio* in the year *1847*, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this Port *April 17 1852* now *summed having changed owner*

And *Reuben Dill* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *One hundred twenty five feet & six inches* her breadth *Twenty five feet and four inches* her depth *ten feet and three inches* and that she measures *301* tons *44* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *single* head

And the said *Reuben Dill* and *head* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.*
