PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Samuel C. Green of Buffalo New York Manager owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing Owner  
of the Schooner Trenton of Buffalo and is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek  
and owns the one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and  
that Samuel Wood who resides at the same place is the  
owner of the remaining one equal undivided half part of  
said Schooner and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner Trenton or Vessel called the  
Trenton of Buffalo whereof said Wood is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of  
Ohio in the year 1843, as appears by her last enrollment dated at  
this port, now surrendered having changed owners

And Enrollment having certified that  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that  
her length is 84 feet & 10 inches  
her breadth 20 " " 5 "  
her depth 8 " " 6 "  
and that she measures 132 tons 66 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has no galley and well head

And the said Samuel C. Green having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
