PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20, 1850.

John B. Densham of Buffalo New York, Managing owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing owner of the Schooner Troy of Buffalo and resides in the District of Buffalo Creek and owns the one equal undivided half part of the said Schooner; and that James Lovel of the Port of Buffalo owns the remaining the other undivided half part of said Schooner, and that they both are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Troy of Buffalo whereof James Lovel is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conneaut State of Ohio in the year 1843, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port Dec 9. 1852 No 133 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 83 feet 8 1/2 inches her breadth 20 " 6 " her depth 7 " 11 " and that she measures 122 tons that she is a Schooner has a scroll

And the said John B. Densham and James Lovel head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
