In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the sole owner of the Schooner *Lea* of Chautaugus Co. N.Y. and is the Manager of said Schooner and owns an equal undivided half part thereof that the said Walker who resides at the same place owns an equal undivided half part thereof that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Lea* or Vessel called the *Lea* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn whereof said Henry Walker

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Silow* State of *New York* in the year 1843 as appears by the last certificate dated at *New York* the 19th September 1850 New hundred having changed owner

And the said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has *one deck* having certified that her length is *sixty four feet and one inch* and that *two masts* and that her breadth is *nineteen feet and one inch* *64 ft 1 inch* her depth *seven feet and seven inches* *19 " 1 "* and that she measures *80* *7 "* tons *17* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has *no galley* and *a scull* head

And the said Henry Walker and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
