And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Mast* and that her length is *Ninety five feet and three inches* *94 ft 3 in* her breadth *Twenty three feet and three inches* *23 ft 3 in* her depth *Eight feet and six inches* *8 ft 6 in* and that she measures *167* tons *H* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has

And the said *Elijah N. Price* a *Scree* head having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
