In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Samuel S. Watrow of Buffalo, N. York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo, New York, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *G. T. Williams* or Vessel called the *G. T. Williams* whereof Samuel S. Watrow, is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving in the State of New York in the year 1846, as appears by New Enrollment dated at this port 23rd February 1854 and Number 19 now surrounded having changed owner

her length is Forty four feet and three inches and that
her breadth Twenty three feet and three inches 94 feet & 3 in
