In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus R. Johnson of Buffalo New York

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milau State of

Ohio in the year 1842 as appears by How enrollment dated at this
port March 8th 1850. No 3. Now summ'd having changed

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that
her length is Eighty two feet Six inches 82 ft 6 in
her breadth Twelve feet Six inches 12 ft 6 in
her depth Eight feet Six inches 8 ft 6 in
and that she measures 144 tons 3 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner and has a screw head

And the said Rufus Johnson and a screw head
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
