### PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Pearl S. Sternburg Merchant, Buffalo New York, managing owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the managing owner of the Propeller *Mary Flower* of Buffalo, that he together with *John H. Russell* and *George H. Bryant* who reside at the Port of Buffalo, of record and *Adelphi Rice* and *David Clapp* who reside at the City of New York are co-partners of the firm of *P. S. Sternburg & Co.* as tenants in common sole owners of said Propeller and are all of them

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Propeller *Mary Flower* of Buffalo *whereof Geo. H. Bryant is at present Master* and he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N. Y. in the year 1853 as appears by the last Enrollment

of said Propeller, dated at this Port April 27, 1853, N. Y. (now surrendered having changed owners) And the said Enrollment having certified that

the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and 2 masts and that her length is 185 feet

And the said Pearl S. Sternburg having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
