



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

John Kennedy of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek New York, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *John Kennedy* or Vessel called the *Lodi of Buffalo* whereof *John Kennedy* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Comauant in the State of Ohio* in the year 1844 as appears by her last Enrollment dated at *Buffalo* this 20th September, 1853 No 123. Now amended having changed owner

And the said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* having certified that her length is *sixty three feet* and that her breadth is *eighteen feet and four inches* and her depth is *six feet and four inches* and that she measures *sixty six tons* twenty four ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *Roll* head

And the said *John Kennedy* and *John Kennedy* head having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
