In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Moreland of Buffalo* whereof *Thomas Stewart* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ohio Lottery* State of *Ohio* in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at *this port* September 20 1853, No 121. Now surrendered bearing changed owner

And the said Enrollment, *Propeller* *Thomas Stewart* having certified that the said *Propeller* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *Two hundred feet & two & three fourth inches*, *200 ft 2 3/4* her breadth *Twenty eight feet & two & three fourth inches*, *28 ft 2 3/4* her depth *Seven feet & two & three fourth inches*, *7 ft 2 3/4* and that she measures *665* tons *8 1/2* ninety-fifths and that she is a *Propeller* has a *Square Stern* and *Round* head

And the said *Andrew D. Ellis* and *Thomas Stewart* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Andrew D. Ellis* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
