

# ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid, that he and Isaac L. Walker of the same place & J. C. Hartman, composing the firm H. C. Walker & Co each now own equal undivided half part of the Schooner *Arvola* of Buffalo, and they both are,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner or Vessel called the *Arvola* of Buffalo, whereof said H. C. Walker is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by our last Enrollment dated at this Port May 26, 1852, No 78, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that her length is One Hundred Seven feet and eight inches 107 ft, 8 in her breadth Twenty three feet and two inches 23 " 10 " her depth Nine feet and one inch 9 " 1 " and that she measures 212, tons 83 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner

And the said Henry C. Walker as signed head having agreed to the description and appraisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
