In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Charles G. Kittow of St. Clair Michigan

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Boat or Vessel called the Lowell of Buffalo whereof Charles G. Kittow is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1848, as appears by Her last enrollment dated Oct 22 February 1853 No 9, now summed having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Boat or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred and twenty one feet 121 feet in her breadth Twenty four feet and two inches 24 " 2 " in her depth Nine feet four and three fourths inches 9 " 3/4 " and that she measures 255 tons 90 — ninety-fifths that she is a Boat has a Scull

And the said Wattow and Charles G. Kittow head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Charles G. Kittow has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
