In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides in the said District and that he and Rufus A Johnson and Charles S Miller both of the same place compose the firm of Morse & Johnson and as said firm own the Schooner Woodham and that all of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Woodham or Vessel called the Woodham whereof Thomas Golligan is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashland State of Ohio in the year 1843, as appears by her Enrollment dated at Ashland Ohio at this port Aug 21. 1851 now surrendered changed owned

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner has one deck and two masts and that her length is 112 feet and 1 1/2 inches her breadth 25 " and 4 " her depth 33 " and 2 " and that she measures 339 tons 80 and that she is a Schooner has a single head

And the said David R Morse and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 5 day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
