In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Curtis Mann, Merchant, of Buffalo, District of Buffalo Creek, Managing owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid and is Managing owner of the Propeller *Saginaw* that himself and George C. Vail and Aaron Vail all of whom reside at the City of Buffalo aforesaid compose the firm of "Mann Vail & Co" and as co-partners of such firm own the whole of said Propeller, and said persons are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller *Saginaw* or Vessel called the *Saginaw* of Buffalo whereof Thomas Crosby is the present Master; and also hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Clio City* State of *Ohio* in the year 1850 - as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port April 13, 1853 No 57. Now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has *one deck* and *one mast* and that her length is *155 feet & 1 inch* her breadth *26 " " 8 "* her depth *10 " " 8 "* and that she measures *407* tons *23* ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has no galleys

And the said Curtis Mann and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
