In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Alexander of Buffalo owns the remaining 2/16 parts of said Propeller Penehalus of Buffalo - and all of them are, and Residents of the District of Buffalo New York, and all of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Penehalus whereof J. Alexander is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Painesville Ohio in the year 1852, as appears by the last enrollment dated at this port November 15, 1853 No 134 Now amended changed, owned,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is One hundred & sixty nine feet 169 feet her breadth Twenty eight 28 feet her depth Eleven feet 11 feet and that she measures 149 tons 47 ninety-fifths and that she is a Propeller has a wheel at the stern and No head

And the said Geo W Holt and No head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
