In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Watson A. Fox, Merchant, of Buffalo, District of Buffalo Creek in having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo afore said and owns one equal undivided half part of the Brig Greyhound of Buffalo and is her Mahogany owner, that Thomas P. Williams who resides at Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Brig; and that both of said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Brig Greyhound or Vessel called the Greyhound of Buffalo whereof William D. Robinson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cincinnati State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port November 5th 1853 No. 130 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 130 feet and her breadth 28 " and her depth 11 " and that she measures 367 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Brig and a scull

And the said Watson A. Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 12 day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
