



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Addison Hills, Gmbr, of Dunkirk, in the District of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek at Dunkirk of record and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Genesee Chief or Vessel called the Genesee Chief whereof George Blackman is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Carthagena State of New York in the year 1846, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port August 22^d 1853 No 117 - now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 140 feet her breadth 25 " 8 inches her depth 12 " 9 1/2 " and that she measures 429 tons 42 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and no figure has a round stern & no galley head

And the said Addison Hills having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
