In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and the owner of the Schooner *Sardis* or Vessel called the *Sardis* ~~Richard~~ whereof *Elijah B. Hibson* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Harro* State of *Ohio* in the year 1847, as appears by the last enrollment dated at this port 5, April 1852, No. 38. Now amended having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and *Two masts* and that her length is *One hundred and seven feet* and *107 feet* her breadth *Twenty four feet and three inches* and *24 " 3 1/2 "* her depth *Eight feet and four inches* and *8 " 4 "* and that she measures *196* tons *63* and that she is a *Sloop* has a *Scroll* head

And the said ~~Charles W. Mallard~~ and *Silas M. Allen* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
