In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Crastus H. Ferris, Mariner of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo
aforesaid and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel called the
C. S. Dennis of Buffalo whereof he the said Ferris is a
Citizen of the United States, and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Troy State of
New York in the year 1849, as appears by her last Enrollment dated
at this port Apr 5, 1853 No 38 now surrendered having
changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is 107 feet
her breadth 23 "
her depth _____
and that she measures 200 1/2 tons & 45 ninety-fifths
that she is a Brig has a square stern
and a roll head

And the said Crastus Ferris having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
