In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

William Sutton, Merchant of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek, Managing Owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo, and is the Managing Owner of the Propeller Opanty of Buffalo that he together with Geo David & A. G. Morgan residents of said Buffalo and N. S. Woodlett who resides at City of New York, compose the firm of Agis Sutton, Geo and as such jointly own your equal undivided half part of said Propeller and that Jesse S. Norton who resides at Toledo, Ohio owned the remaining One equal, undivided half part of said Propeller, and all the said Opanty and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Opanty of Buffalo whereof Jesse S. Norton is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City in the year 1848, as appears by her last enrollment dated at the port of Toledo, Ohio November 8, 1851. Now surrendered and changed owners

And said enrollment having certified that she said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is 152 feet and seven inches her breadth 22 " 9 1/2 " her depth 10 " 3 1/2 " and that she measures 343 tons 37 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and a square stern

And the said William Sutton and Jesse S. Norton head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
