In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Henry C. Walker, merchant of Buffalo N.Y. managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Schooner "Pearl" and owns one equal undivided half of her, and that John Smith resides at Milan Ohio and owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said vessel and said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner or Vessel called the  
*Pearl of Buffalo* whereof *Thomas Green*  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Toledo* in the State of  
*Ohio* in the year *1847*, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at  
*this Port* *Apr 28 1853* No *63*. now surrendered having changed  
owners,

And said Enrollment  
the said Schooner or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* having certified that  
her length is *106* feet *9* inches and that  
her breadth *20* " *8* "  
her depth *8* " *2* "  
and that she measures *151* tons *14* ninety-fifths  
that she is a *Schooner* has a square stern and no figure head

And the said *Henry C. Walker* and *no figure* head  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo, N Y.**
