

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

James Butler, Mariner, of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of said Buffalo and is the owner of the Schooner "N. L. Manning" and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner or Vessel called the "N. L. Manning" of Buffalo whereof said Butler is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at French Creek in the State of New York in the year 1848, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Ogdensburg Apr 20, 1853 No 3, now surrendered having changed owners.

And by said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 82 feet & 6 inches her breadth 19 " 0 " her depth 6 " 9 " and that she measures 85 tons & 87 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galley and no figure head

And the said James Butler having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
