In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing owner of the Brig Tuscarora of Buffalo and that he together with Geo Davis and Abel H Morgan, residents of said Buffalo and Henry Woodstock of the City of New York compose the firm of Davis Sutton and Company and as such firm are the sole owners of the said Brig and all of them are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Tuscarora of Buffalo whereof is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at North East State of Pennsylvania in the year 1857, as appears by New Enrollment dated at this Port February 11 1854 No 12 now renewed having changed names

And said Enrollment by Owen Dyer and Tom Mast having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has her length is One Hundred feet and that her breadth is Seventy five feet two and one half inches 25 1/2 ft and that she measures Ten feet and four inches 10 " 1" and that she measures 253 tons 81 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig and has

And the said Owen Dyer and Tom Mast head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said
