In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Nathan Rice, of Newburgh New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing owner of the Schooner Homer Ramsdell, and is the owner of one equal undivided half part of said Schooner, that Thomas Powell Homer Ramsdell and David Moore also reside at said Newburgh and compose the Copartnership of Powell Ramsdell & Co. from as much from the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and, all said persons are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner
 Homer Ramsdell whereof Nathan Rice is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port April 16th 1853 & numbered (67) now surrendered (changed owners)

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and four masts and that her length is 119 feet her breadth 26 " her depth 9 " 9 inches and that she measures 275 tons 91 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has
