In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the Managing Owner of the Schooner "L. Revere" of Buffalo. And, on oath, and equal undivided half part of said Schooner, that Thomas Powell, Warner Ramsdell and David Moore who reside at said Newburgh and comprise the firm of Powell Ramsdell & Company own as such firm the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and all said part and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner "L. Revere" or Vessel called the "L. Revere of Buffalo" whereof Sarah Revere is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port May 5 1853 & No 74, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 119 feet her breadth 25 " 8 inches her depth 10 " " and that she measures 279 tons 80 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has

And the said Nathaw Revere and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
