In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Hugh W. Miller of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner
Morning Star of Buffalo whereof he is Samuel Herkes
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Whitabalah State of
in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment dated of this
port of May 14. 1853 now surrendered having changed
