In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act August 30th, 1852, ~~and also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.~~

Harvey M. Miller, Merchant of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the schooner called "Three Bells" of Buffalo, and owns one equal undivided half part of thereof; that Harry B. Miller resides at Orango Ohio and owns the remaining one equal half part of said schooner and said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Three Bells Buffalo Schooner vessel called the "Three Bells" of Buffalo whereof William Walker is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of J. N. Jones, Shipwright, the builder on file in this office

And Thomas Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and 2 masts and that her length is 124 feet 7 6 inches her breadth 26 " " 3 " her depth 10 " " 3 " and that she measures 305 tons 47 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head

And the said Harvey M. Miller having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
