In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he together with Jeremiah Lee of the same place, & John A. Hill & Maria A. Lee of Buffalo and Newell Chamberlain of the City of New York, Comprising the firm of Lee Hill & Company, and as such firm own the equal undivided one half part of the Propeller Detroit of Buffalo, that W. H. Buckingham and J. S. Guthrie of the City of Buffalo own and copartners of the firm of Buckingham & Guthrie own equal undivided one fourth part of said Propeller and that John A. Montgomery, of the City of Buffalo, owns the remaining one equal undivided one fourth part of said Propeller, Detroit, and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller Detroit of Buffalo whereof John A. Montgomery is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit in the State of Michigan in the year 1845, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 26, 1853, Number 84, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is One Hundred and twenty eight feet six inches — 128 ft 6 in her breadth Twenty five feet — 25 ft 0 in her depth Nine feet and two inches — 9 ft 2 in and that she measures 293 tons 71 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller

And the said Charles W. Lee head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
