In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Amos R. Cobb - Merchant of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid and is the Managing of the Propeller Sam of Buffalo and owned equal undivided twelfth parts of said Propeller, and that Andrew Anderson who resides at said Buffalo owned two equal undivided twelfth parts of said Propeller, and Cornelius J. Ferguson resides at said Buffalo and owned one undivided twelfth part of said Propeller and all said owned, and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Sam of Buffalo whereof Andrew Anderson is at present Master; and he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port April 29 1854, No 98, now surrendered having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 191 feet 11 inches her breadth 28 " 6 " her depth 12 " 0 " and that she measures 629 32 95 tons that she is a Propeller has a square stern

And the said Amos R. Cobb and M. Ferguson head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller, has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
