In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the ~~of~~ of ~~Refugees on~~ board ~~Ships propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~ passed 7th July, 1838, and the ~~Act~~ ~~of~~ ~~August~~ 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of ~~Ships,~~ and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he together with Isaac C. Walker of the City of Buffalo, are the owners of the equal undivided three eighths parts of the Brig Lucy A Blossom and that Marshall Cadron of Cornwall Ohio is the owner of the remaining equal undivided one fourth part of said Brig Lucy A Blossom, and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Lucy A Blossom or Vessel called the Lucy A Blossom whereof Franklin Wilcox is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Franklin Wilcox is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cornwall State of Ohio in the year 1846, as appears by New Enrollment dated April 28 July 1853, No 110, now renewed changed owned.

And the said Enrollment, Henry C. Walker having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 117 feet and 4 inches her breadth 24 " " 9 " her depth 9 " " 98 " and that she measures 258 tons 9 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a single head
