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In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Paul L. Sterburg, Merchant of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, N. Y., having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, New York, and is the Managing owner of the Propeller called the *Thyrsanth* of Buffalo, that she is owned by the Proprietors, Pearl L. Sterburg, Geo. of Buffalo, aforesaid, that said firm is composed of said Sterburg and Levi H. Remwell and George H. Bryant of the said Buffalo and Addison Rice and Everett Clapp of the City of New York; that the said owners are all of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the *Thyrsanth* Propeller or Vessel called the *Thyrsanth* of Buffalo whereof George H. Bryant is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at this City, in the State of Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of the Surveyor of the firm of Lapinier & Stevenson Shipwrights his builders, on file at this office.

And *Horace Hoffman* Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and that her length is 212 feet 6 3/4 inches her breadth 32 " 4 " her depth 12 " 10 1/2 " and that she measures 846 tons 40 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and Scull head

And the said *Pearl L. Sterburg* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
