In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same,~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

George D. Fargo, Master of Chicago, Illinois, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the City of Chicago, in the State of Illinois, and the sole owner of the Schooner Grand Turk of Buffalo, now lying at the Port of Buffalo Creek, (and being destined for Chicago) and which was ~~at~~ ^{transit} at the time of his purchase thereof; and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Grand Turk of Buffalo, whereof he said cargo is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York, in the year 1854, as appears by her last enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo May 12, 1854, and is now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 130 feet 8 inches her breadth 25 feet 7 inches her depth 10 feet 7 inches and that she measures 327 tons, 43 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square beam and a scroll head

And the said George D. Fargo, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
