In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus R. Johnson of Buffalo, District of Buffalo Creek,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Schooner "Lodi" of Buffalo; that said Schooner is owned by the Copartnership doing business at said Buffalo under the firm of "More and Johnson" which firm is composed of said Johnson and David R. More & Charles G. Miller all of said Buffalo; and that all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner or Vessel called the "Lodi" of Buffalo whereof John Kennedy is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Leonaht Ohio in the year 1841, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 15, 1853 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two Masts and that her length is 63 feet her breadth 19 " 4 inches her depth 6 " 4 " and that she measures 66 tons 24 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a

And the said Rufus R. Johnson and Scholl head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
