In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for regarding the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

I, Augustus A. Ormiston of Westfield N.Y. Manager Owner, of the Schooner L. C. Butts having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek, that said Schooner is owned by the Partnership doing business at Parceland N.Y. under the firm of Henri Fort & Company which firm is composed of said Ormiston and Henri Fort and David H. Taylor Wm. J. Dennison of Westfield N.Y. and Henri Fort of Parceland N.Y. each of said owners owning an equal undivided fourth part of said Schooner L. C. Butts of Buffalo, and all of said owners, are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner L. C. Butts whereof Samuel Fellows of Oran N.Y. is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Caledonia N.Y. in the year 1852, as appears by New Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio 28 March 1853, No 3 was furnished changed annul

And the said Enrollment Ormiston and Fellows having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is Ninety one feet and that her breadth is Twenty two feet and nine inches and that she measured Eight feet and Eleven inches and that she is a Schooner has a 165 tons 18 ninety-fifths

And the said Augustus A. Ormiston and Samuel Fellows head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Ormiston has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
