In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

John G. Dodge of Buffalo New York Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of said Buffalo, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner North Carolina whereof New Drury is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheffield Ohio in the year 1835. And rebuilt and enlarged at Buffalo State N.Y. in the year 1854. As appears by the Certificate of George H. Stewart Shipwright on file in this office

And Phocrow Hoffman Surveyor, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 111 feet 3 inches her breadth 21 1/2 " " " her depth " " " and that she measures 141 tons 71 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said John G. Dodge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
