In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Robert Mills of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Pittsburgh or Vessel called the Pittsburgh whereof said Mills is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port August 5 1850; now demanded Change of name,

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts her length is 87 feet her breadth 20 " 4 inches her depth 8 " 7 " and that she measures 137 tons 83 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has A Square Stern and A Scull head

And the said Robert Mills has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner
