In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Managing Owner James O. Evans, of Buffalo New York

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo New York and is the owner of the equal undivided Three fourth parts of the Propeller "Sciota of Buffalo", and that Ches Engle of Buffalo is the owner of the remaining One equal undivided One fourth part of said Propeller, and both of them are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Sciota of Buffalo whereof Calvin Merrick is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Morrow Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this port April 15th 1851. No 26. Now Summers and having changed owner,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has for deck and One mast and that her length is One Hundred fifty four feet six inches and that her breadth is Twenty four feet 15 1/2 ft 6 in and that she measures Eleven feet 2 1/2 ft 11 in and that she is a Propeller has a Sharp Stern and No head

And the said James O. Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
